## PCHS Expectations & Extensions for Math 1 Class

### 1. Be present & on time

## Policies & Procedures

**Warm-Ups** for a week can be completed on the Warm Up sheet provided to you. The sheet will be collected at the end of two weeks and then be recorded as a weekly classwork grade in **PowerSchools**.

**Student Engagement** opportunities will be available throughout the quarter. You will receive a student engagement sheet to keep track of your points. Ways to earn points will be by attending Smart Lunch, making test corrections, classwork (when announced), and review activities.

You will be assigned **Homework** each Friday and it will be due the following Friday. The assignments will be available on **CANVAS**. Your homework will be graded for accuracy and be recorded as a weekly homework grade in PowerSchools.

There will be at least one **QUIZ** per unit. Each quiz will be corrected during that same class period so that you can go back and try those missed problems again.

One **TEST** will be given per unit. At least a portion of each test will be short answer and the rest will be multiple choice. This is to prepare you for your final exam in at the end of the semester.

If you miss a quiz or test, you will be expected to take it **within 3 days of returning to school**.

All assignments from class should be made up when you return if not sooner. You will find notes on **CANVAS** and your missing assignments/notes will be available in the classroom. Please follow WCPSS make-up policy. All make-up work must be completed one week prior to the end of the quarter to guarantee accurate grades on report cards.
